Finances: The \$100,000 donation that went directly to pay off the mortgage, saved an estimated similar amount in interest (\$100,000). We now owe about \$340,000 on our mortgage.

In order to determine how to spend the remaining \$50,000 on projects and maintenance the Trustees are asking every team to make recommendations as to what projects/repairs they feel are important and to bring those to the next Commons Council with estimated costs. We are asked to look at these by categories of: maintenance, large projects and mid/small. These can also be sent to Victor but will be presented and discussed at our next Council on July 3.
